

# *Ebony* & *Ivory* janice brown monte stephens™

## *Biography*

Under the direction of Gerri' Dee, producer for Freedom Records, two voices from two music genres, where made one. Echoing from the past, Janice Brown once again returns to the studio and steps into the gospel recording scene. Brown made history in 1983 becoming the first black gospel group to go Gold. The recording "Rough Side of the Mountain" with F. C. Barnes shot them to the top. Monte Stephens labeled "The God Father of Christian Country Music", with three number one songs, six international Top 20 hits and a twelve-time Grammy contender, completes "Ebony & Ivory."

Dee said, "With the guiding of the Holy Spirit, my goal was not to bring two powerful voices together, but two anointed God-called ministers at the mike together to reach souls for His kingdom." Gerri' Dee reached that goal and then some. "ALIVE & WELL" was a musical experience like I have never witnessed. Charged with the Holy Spirit, unity, anointing, love, and vocal uniqueness, the precedented musical arrangements lead by Pat Severs and Studio IV engineer Ken Isham at the mixing board, it all happened.

Those who have heard "ALIVE & WELL" are making all kinds of predictions of the future of this album. FORGET ALL OF THAT! Sit down at a quiet time, uninterrupted by anything in the world. Let the music take you into a heavenly place with Christ Jesus. For this purpose only was this recording done. If that does not happen for you, then "ALIVE & WELL" to you, is just another album.
